- 2 PORTAL** Specially commissioned artwork inside & outside St James' Church, made by artist William Lindley & students from Spilsby Primary Academy and King Edward VI Academy
- 3 SENSORY GAZEBO** Step into space in a world *out of this world* created by students & staff from Eresby School
- 4 SHADOW PLAY** What can your shadows do?
- 5 CHROMA CLOCK** Can you work out how to tell the time with this colour projection?
- 6 BENEDICITE** Specially commissioned artwork by William Lindley inspired by Sir John Franklin's adventures.  
*Duration 5 minutes; this piece will run every 15 minutes from 6.30pm to 8.30pm*
- 7 MAZES** Can you get in & out before the maze changes?
- 8 LIGHT NIGHT** Take your selfies by our super bright sign
- 9 SPILSBY SPIRAL** New thoughts on top of old ones about why we love Spilsby, by Y4 & Y5 children from the Primary Academy
- 10 SMILE!** Can you find the camera?

Public toilets are available on the Market Place and  First Aid points are at the Sessions House and the Methodist Church.

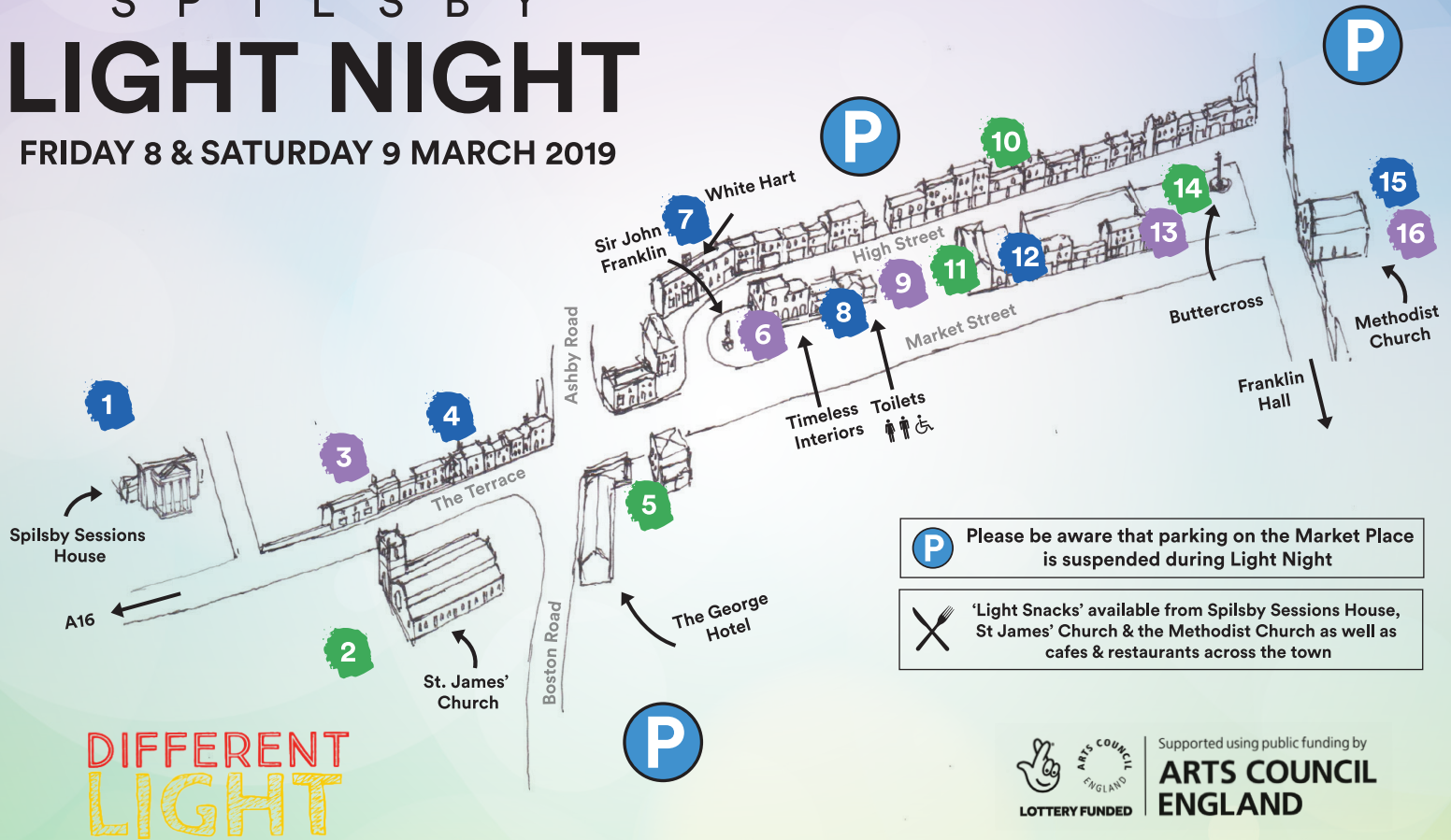
